



## Curriculum Sheet Instructions

The purpose of this sheet is to assist educators in creating incidental learning opportunities for their students during Autism Day at Six Flags Great Adventure. This sheet is intentionally vague to allow room for educators to create custom activities and lessons based on the individual needs of their students.

The document identifies key areas that educators can build lessons around in order to expand the day's educational elements. Educators have complete creative freedom to use this sheet to fit their needs, but the creators suggest creating "scavenger hunt" or "bingo" style activities.

### Some examples of this include:

- Have your student introduce themselves to 5 new people.
- Have your student share one fact about themselves and learn one interesting fact about another person.
- Have your student point to the rides, restaurants or shops that interest them on the map and communicate what they want to do next.

The special needs staff (provided by Gersh Academy) throughout the park will be there to assist with these activities and are the perfect target for the lessons. Feel free to have your students approach our staff (identified by colored "Autism Day at Six Flags" shirts) and fulfill one of your activities.
